

LEGAL NOTICE
TOWN OF WESTBROOK

The legal voters of the Town of Westbrook, Connecticut and all others qualified to vote in meetings of said Town are hereby notified and warned that the Annual Town Meeting will be held in the Multi Purpose Room at the Teresa Mulvey Municipal Center, 866 Boston Post Road on Monday, April 20, 2009 at 7:30 p.m. to consider and act on the following:

1. To designate April 27, 2009 as the date for the Annual Town Budget Meeting of the Town of Westbrook, Connecticut, in conformance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 7-388 for the purpose of acting upon the Annual Town Budget for the Fiscal July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.
2. To nominate and elect one (1) Fire Commissioner to serve for a term of three (3) years to April 30, 2012, pursuant to Section 7-21 of Westbrook Code of Ordinances.
3. To nominate and elect one (1) Forest Commissioner to serve for a term of three (3) years to April 29, 2012 pursuant to Section 9-162 of the Westbrook Code of Ordinances.
4. To nominate and elect four (4) Fair Rent Commissioners to serve for a term of Four (4) years to May 15, 2013 pursuant to Section 20-202 of the Westbrook Code of Ordinances.
5. To nominate and elect nine (9) members to the Board of Recreation for the Town of Westbrook for three (3) year term from May 13, 2009 to May 13, 2012, pursuant to Section 14-23 of the Westbrook Code of Ordinances.
6. Resolved: That Chapter 9, Land Use Regulations, Article V, Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission, of the Code of Ordinances be amended to add new sections as follows:

Section 9-87, Power to Issue Citations and Impose Fines.

Section 9-88, Appointment of Citation Hearing Officer(s) and Procedure for Conducting Hearing.

Section 9-89, Citation Hearing Procedure

Section 9-90, Payment of Fines, Civil Penalties, Costs and/or Fees.

Section 9-91, Retention of Records

The purpose of the amended sections is to provide for a citation and hearing procedure for the enforcement of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations of the Town of Westbrook.

Copies of the new sections are on file with the office of the Town Clerk and available for public inspection during normal business hours.

7. Resolved: That the Board of Selectmen are hereby authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary to authorize a three year agreement with Veolia Environmental Services, pursuant to the Inter-Local Agreement with other Connecticut River Estuary Region towns for the regional household hazardous waste collection program, the terms of said agreement to be negotiated through the Connecticut River Estuary Regional Planning Agency for all participating towns and subject to approval of the Board of Selectmen
